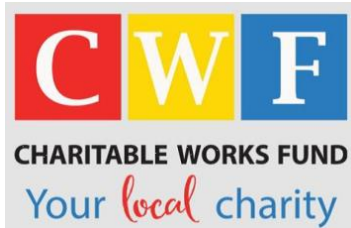
Not from the Pulpit: Fr Andrew Bullen SJ



At the beginning of secondary State schooling in Wales we had to do a year of Welsh (and French, German and Latin); then we had to choose between Welsh and French. I rather wish I had stuck with Welsh. Nowadays I can only pronounce but not translate in my head the following famous place name: Llan-fair-pwll-gwyn-gyll-gogerych-wyrn-drob-wyll-llan-tysilio-gogogoch; meaning: “The church of St Mary in the hollow of white hazel trees near the rapid whirlpool by St Tysilio’s of the red cave”. “Mair” is Welsh for “Mary”; when an “m” at the start of the word is preceded by a word like “llan” (meaning “saint”) it mutates to “f”, so we have “Llanfair”; Celtic languages have this mutation thing. Closer to home, one can imagine: “St Mary’s church at the busy crossroads and St Francis

Xavier’s of the green spire and Star of the Sea in the hollow by the great tree and shining water nearby”: “Llanfair...” (translation into Welsh pending).
