

Not from the Pulpit: Fr Nguyen Trung SJ



January 28 ushers in the Lunar New Year of the Rooster. For the many countries that celebrate this event, it is the most significant festival of the year and for every year. It is a time to take a break from the normal daily activities, and come together for family reunions, for settling accounts, and for renewed hope in peace and prosperity. It is also a time for giving to express one's generosity and prosperity, through the giving of gifts and red envelopes of money to children.

There is also a sacred and mythical aspect to this festival. It is believed that there is a Kitchen God in each household, and this god hears and sees everything, for conversations occurs in the kitchen during meal times, and he would return to heaven at the end of each year to give a report to the Lord of Heaven. This reveals that the Lord of Heaven is very much interested and concerned about the welfare of the people on earth, and would dispense punishments or blessings, through children, health, peace, the weather, harvest, and prosperity, according to the report of the Kitchen God. Hence the New Year is a time for making peace with God and others, and also to give thanks for the blessings of the year passed, to pray for one's ancestors and to ask for God's blessings in the coming new year. In the gospels, Peter thrice denied Jesus and was awakened by the rooster's crow and repented. In this New Year of the Rooster, we pray that we are also spiritually awakened to make peace with God and with each other, and pray for peace and blessings in our world.
